E. Stanley Jones, the great Methodist missionary to India, had an interview with Mahatma Gandhi, the great leader of the Indian independence movement.

Jones said, "You are perhaps the leading Hindu of India. Could you tell me what you think we as Christians should do to make Christianity... part of the national life—something which contributes its power to India's uplift and redemption?"

Gandhi suggested this: "All you Christians... must begin to live more like Jesus Christ. You must practice your religion without adulterating it or toning it down."

He went on to tell Jones that we Christians "must emphasize love and make it [our] working force, for love is central in Christianity."

How about that?

A Hindu in India in 1919 dares to instruct us Methodists in Georgia in 2009!

I don't think I can say it any better than he did!

Live like Jesus Christ. Practice our faith without toning it down. Make love our working force.
