Speed skater Jennifer Rodriguez was an unlikely choice to represent the USA in the 2002 Winter Olympics. To begin with, she hails from Miami, Florida—not exactly the Mecca of winter sports. Second, she learned to ice skate only six years before her Olympic debut.

Rodriguez was part of the “in-line invasion,” a still growing number of racers who got their start as in-line roller skaters. To make the transition to ice, in-line skaters have to learn new techniques, such as crossing their skates in the turns. When a skater brings her back leg forward in a turn, the back skate must cross over the front skate. Otherwise, she could lose speed or, worse, fly off the track.

Learning a few new moves enabled Jennifer Rodriguez to claim an Olympic medal.

What new moves might God invite us to learn and practice as sources of strength in our lives? A renewed life of prayer? A commitment to forgive? A fresh generosity in response to God's grace?

These and other new moves can only lead us to a place of greater strength as we seek the Lord together.
