True worship is connection with the life of God.

True worship is communication with the Spirit of God.

True worship is communion with the Son of God, Jesus Christ.

True worship is confession that he is faithful and we are fallen.

True worship is celebration of the Father's work in the past.

True worship is contemplation of his redeeming work in our future.
