But advertisers aren't the only ones who hope to spur people to action based on the public profile of others.

The Old Testament prophet Isaiah, when trying to tell the people of Israel to return to their roots and trust God, invoked the faith of father Abraham (Isaiah 51:1-2).

When Jesus met a Roman soldier, he commended the man's faith and compared it to Abraham's (Matthew 8:10-11).

Chapter 11 in the New Testament letter to the Hebrews doesn't stop with Abraham but gives us a whole "laundry list" of heroes whose faith is worth copying, from Abel and Enoch to Rahab, Samuel, and a host of unnamed saints.

I like the fact that Hebrews mentions these "anonymous" saints—the ones who followed God in good times and bad, in success and failure, in weakness and strength, in life and death. I like it because I have a suspicion that I'll end up on that kind of list, and that you'll end up on that kind of list with me.

We won't be famous enough to appear in a major advertising campaign, but our lives will be noticed. Our lives will be different. Our faith in Jesus Christ will touch the people around us, and they'll give thanks to God for it and for us.

That's what All Saints' Sunday is all about. It's a day for us to acknowledge all those whose faith has been alive, with the hopes that their example will spur us on to trust Christ also.
