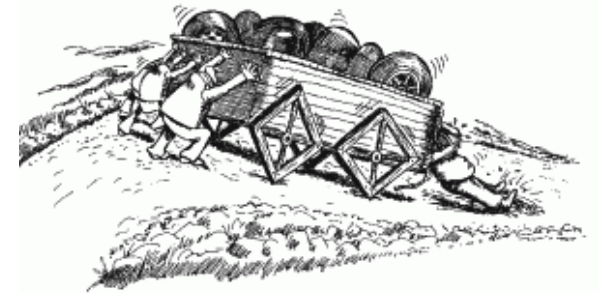

This cartoon illustrates our (sometimes frustrating) experience in church. God has promised to give us everything we need to do the job he's called us to, but we often use the wrong tools.

Paul wrote it this way: "Therefore you do not lack any spiritual gift as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed." (1 Corinthians 1:7)

Through the gift of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, God gives us the round wheels we need to grow in our personal faith and to grow in our community of faith—the church.

Our church will soon begin a process called *Natural Church Development*. The NCD principles will help us find the round wheels God has already put in our church's cart... the wheels we need to start using to get where the Lord wants to take us.
