We planted some pansies by the back porch this winter. The Lord only knows how they survived the icy nights and the Noah-like rains. Now these flowers give us a little splash of color in this muddy season.

"The Lord only knows" is the right thing to say, whether we're talking about growing pansies or trees or farms or people or churches. God holds to the key to healthy growth.

That's not to diminish our part in the process. Amy and the boys dug out old roots and pulled weeds. Patty measured out the placement of the plants. I broke them loose from the trays.

Paul describes the work of the growing church in Corinth this way: "I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow." (1 Corinthians 3:6)

Notice, he takes credit for what he did himself. He gives credit to Apollos (a well-known Christian teacher and preacher who gets mentioned in several places in the New Testament). Paul's work and Apollos' work were both essential.

Natural Church Development has the potential to help us know where and how to plant, to water, to harvest, so that we can take full advantage of God's work to make our church grow.

We can't make it grow by ourselves. Yet we know that our planting and watering can influence the expected harvest, when God makes it grow.

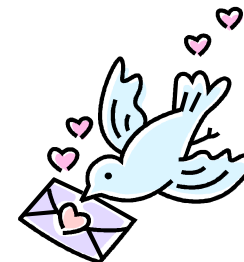
