“The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.” (Psalm 19:1)

Teddy Roosevelt began an evening Cabinet meeting pointing out various stars from the White House balcony. He directed his advisers back inside, saying, “Now that we feel small enough, let's begin our work.”

The heavens can make us feel small, but they can also make us increase our concept of God's greatness, his wonderful design for the universe.

Astronomers like Dr. Pamela Gay tell us that around 13 billion years ago, the first generation of stars were created, burned out, and collapsed. These stars “died” to pave the way for second-generation stars like our Sun, stars rich in metallic elements like iron and titanium. Iron and titanium, which can only form after the death of a star, are absolutely necessary for the creation of a planet like our Earth.

In the season of Lent, we take stock of our relationship with a God whose Son died so that we would have life. Maybe God has been hinting at wonder of the Resurrection for billions of years before it finally happened... just because he could.
