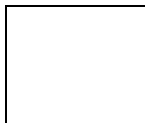

I like to think that, despite the disappointment that it has only been one year, you will be able to say God has comforted our church as well—that we seem stronger in our desire to worship him, to fellowship together, to embrace those he sends to us, to serve him in the world.

None of us planned to make this a one-year experience. But God has used us together in good ways, and this will be one year with many memories.

I will continue to pray for you, that God will comfort you and give you strength.
