

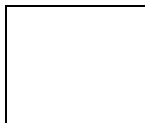

In 1870, after nearly one hundred years as widespread state and local Celebrations, the Fourth of July became an unpaid Federal holiday (it was changed to a paid holiday in 1938). In some way or another, officially or unofficially, the anniversary of our freedom has been celebrated since 1777. For 233 years we have acknowledged our Declaration of Independence from England, our Constitution, and the brave people who framed and fought for this new nation. The fireworks this Sunday remind us of the unbroken line of Liberty—first painted, and continued, in the blood and service of patriots and heroes. Let us never forget.

About 1,980 years ago, our freedom was drafted not by quill and parchment, but by mallet and nails. For nearly two millennia we have celebrated this moment weekly. It has been well kept in both the hands of the scholars and the lives of the martyrs. Our independence has been declared from the tyranny and hopelessness of life without God. The service this Sunday reminds us of the unbroken line of Love—painted in the blood of Christ and continued in the service of Christians the world over. Let us never forget.
