What is needed: Bicycles large enough for college students to ride. BMX and “freestyle” bikes with 20-inch wheels won't work. Cruiser-class BMX bikes (24-inch wheels) might work for smaller students, but any type of 26-or-27 inch wheel bikes would be best. This includes road, mountain, trail, city, and beach cruiser cycles. Both men's and women's styles are welcome. If you would like to donate a bike, bring it to the church.
